Focus Group Interview as a Tool for Qualitative Research ...

Focus group or focus group interview is a qualitative technique for data collection A focus group is “a group comprised of individuals with certain characteristics who focus discussions on a given issue or topic” (Anderson, 1990, p241) According to Denscombe (2007, p115), “focus group consists of a small group of people, usually
