By 1900, scientists realised not all diseases were caused by microbes Discovery of DNA (1953) meant scientists understood how hereditary diseases were caused Eg Down [s Syndrome Crick and Watson Lifestyle choices impact on health: smoking, poor diet, alcohol, sharing of bodily fluids and exposure to excessive amounts of sun
